

Chief Minister, Himachal Pradesh Reviews Rain Damages over Video Conferencing

The Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh, Professor Prem Kumar Dhumal reviewed the damage caused in the State due to continuous rains for the last few days on 18th August 2008 and the relief provided by the Administration.



The VC was conducted by NIC from the Chief Minister office. The Ministers of Revenue, PWD, Irrigation and Public Health were present along with the Principal Secretaries of Revenue, Excise & Taxation, Home, IPH, Education, Information & Technology.

All the Deputy Commissioners and concerned officers from PWD, IPH and Revenue Department participated from the respective District Headquarters.

The Chief Minister reviewed the damage caused due to loss of human life, cattle, houses, roads, irrigation and drinking water schemes. He laid particular stress on flood control measures, prompt repair of roads and providing safe drinking water.
