

CM takes stock of essentials, enquires about Hajj flights

JAMMU: Chief Minister (CM), Ghulam Nabi Azad has asked the administration to keep a constant vigil on price line of essentials and further speed up execution of development works for time bound completion thereof. He also enquired about the Hajj flights leaving from Srinagar on Wednesday.

CM was taking stock of supply and stock position of essential commodities and pace of progress on infrastructure development projects in view of snowfall in upper reaches of the State, with Deputy Commissioners (DCs) of Doda and Srinagar through video conference facility of NIC at Civil Secretariat here on Wednesday. CM enquired from DC Srinagar about the operation of Hajj flights from Srinagar on Wednesday. He

also enquired from the DC about the availability of essential commodities as well as the arrangements made for snow clearance during winter months.

DC Srinagar informed that two Hajj flights carrying 422 pilgrims left from Srinagar on

Wednesday. He said that so far 8,138 Hajj pilgrims from the State have left for the pilgrimage whereas the last Hajj flight from the summer capital of the State is scheduled to leave on Thursday.

DC also said that adequate stock of essential commodities

was available in the district and market checking teams have been constituted to keep an eye on price line of essential commodities. He said that adequate arrangements have been made for snow clearance and administration is fully geared up to meet the situation. Azad while taking stock of availability of food grains and other essential commodities in Doda District particularly in its upper reaches in view of winter and snowfall was informed by DC Doda, Sourab Bhagat that sufficient stocks of food grains is available in the district to meet requirement of the people.

DC also apprised CM about pace of progress on construction of roads and other development projects in the district. Principal Secretary to CM Anil Goswami was also present during the video conferencing.
